Example Location Table

A word from column 1 plus a word from column 2 describes a location and a map reference.

So, BROWN/FOUNT says you will find a code word(s) *Hanging from the Notice Board* in grid square **6453** – the exact map reference (to the nearest metre) being 64**245**/53**339**, although for plotting purposes 642/533 may be accurate enough given the location description.
